The State Counsel accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, hence issuance of notice stands dispensed-with. Also heard on I.A No. 01 of 2019, which is application for grant of interim relief. Considering the fact that, the petitioner has worked as a Vidya Mitaa for two consecutive previous years of academic sessions and taking note of the order of the School Education Department dated 02.08.2019, whereby there is a specific instruction for granting appointment / engaging the services of Vidya Mitaa first and thereafter others can be considered, prima-facie a strong case for grant of interim relief made out. Accordingly, it is ordered that in the Government Higher Secondary School-Kalcha, District: Bastar in the said subject in which the petitioner was working as a Vidya Mitaa shall not be filled in by the concerned school authorities till further order passed by this Court.
