28.11.2024	Ms Kavita Bansal, counsel for the applicant. Ms Binu Sharma, counsel for the respondent. Heard on IA-1 of 2023, application for delay in filing the revision. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that the <i>ex parte</i> order has been passed against him and no proper notice has been served upon him, therefore, he was not in knowledge of passing of order, and as and when he came into knowledge of the impugned order passed against him, he filed present Criminal Revision, which is delayed by 407 days. Learned counsel for the respondent objected and submitted that notice was issued to the respondent on his given address but he avoided to take service of summons, and therefore, <i>ex parte</i> order was passed. Applicant was having knowledge from the very beginning about the proceedings, and there is no proper explanation

	for causing delay. Therefore, IA-1 of 2023 may be dismissed. Considering the submissions of learned counsel for the parties, and for the reasons mentioned in the application, IA-1 of 2023 is allowed and the delay of 407 days in filing the revision is hereby condoned.
