01/04/2026	Mr. Rakesh Thakur, learned, learned counsel for the appellants. Mr. Samir Singh, learned counsel for respondent/Insurance Company. Heard on I. A. No. 02 of 2024, which is an application for condonation of delay of 08 days in filing the appeal. Though opposed but for the reason stated in the application, the application I. A. No. 02 of 2024 is allowed. Delay of 08 days in filing the appeal is condoned. Heard on admission. Appeal is admitted for hearing. Issue notice to the respondents. Mr. Singh, learned counsel for respondent No. 3 accepts notice. Also heard on application (I. A. No. 1 of 2024) for grant of stay. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that by the impugned award, the Insurance Company was exonerated

from payment of compensation, however, doctrine of pay and recovery was applied, thus, the Insurance Company has deposited the entire amount of compensation and in execution filed by the Insurance Company, the appellant has also deposited Rs. 4,25,000/-.

Be that as it may, on further depositing of Rs. 2 lacs before the Claims Tribunal within a period of 60 days from today, recovery of remainder shall remain stayed against the appellant.

Post this matter alongwith MAC No. 1799 of 2024 for final hearing in the months of September, 2026.
