01/10/2019	Mr. Ghanshyam Kashyap, Advocate, for the Petitioners. Ms. Abhyunnati Singh, Panel Lawyer, for Respondent-State. Heard on admission as well as on I.A. No.1 which is an application for grant of interim relief. Issue notice to the Respondents on admission as well as on I.A. No.1 by ordinary as well as registered mode on payment of process fee to be paid within a period of 7 days from today, failing which the present writ petition shall stand dismissed without reference to the Court. Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Respondent-State has till date not issued order of appointment to the private Respondents and that they do not have the requisite eligibility criteria under the rules for holding the post of Rural Horticulture Extension Officer and the Respondent-State with malafide intentions or arbitrarily has held the private Respondents to be eligible. Counsel for the Petitioner further submits that the private Respondents are even not entitled for relaxation which otherwise prescribed under the Chhattisgarh Ex-servicemen (Reservation of Vacancies in the State Civil Services and Post Class-III and Class-IV) Rules, 1985. Given the said facts and circumstances of the case, the Respondent-State is as of now restrained from issuing any further order of appointment, if it has not been issued till date, to the private Respondents for the post of Rural Horticulture Extension Officer from among the Ex-servicemen quota.
