14.10.2019	Mr. R.K. Kesharwani, counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Soumya Rai, P.L., appears for the State/R-1 & R-2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was working as Rojgar Sahayak on contract basis and on the recommendation of respondent no.3 pursuant to an enquiry held behind his back directed respondent no.4 to terminate the service of the petitioner. It is contended that the said enquiry was conducted without giving any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the finding of the enquiry conducted behind the back of petitioner would have an adverse affect on him and ultimately it would result in termination. Issue consolidated notice to respondents 3 & 4 on payment of PF as per rules. Considering the averments made that the petitioner's service has been terminated without there being any opportunity of hearing to him, it is directed that the recommendation dated 16.09.2019 shall not be acted upon till the next date of hearing.
