Nos.01/2026 & 02/2026. Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, therefore, PF is not required to be paid. Issue notice to respondents No.4 to 9 (on admission as well as I.A. Nos. 01/2026 & 02/2026). Process fee be paid within 07 working days from today. Notice be served through ordinary mode as well as speed post. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that though he was not made a party in the proceeding, however his land has also been added and as such he has filed this petition

Vasant	while filing application for seeking leave to file writ petition. He would further submit that earlier the proceeding under Section 170-B of the Land Revenue Code was culminated and subsequently the legal heirs have been instituted second proceeding in which both the Courts, i.e., SDO(R) as well as the Collector have dismissed the application as well as the appeal and stating that there is no requirement to initiate second proceeding. However, the said revision was filed before the concerned Commissioner and the Commissioner has set aside the order and has directed for reversion of the land in question as such this petition has been filed. Learned State counsel prays for and is granted two weeks' time to file reply and would submit that issue notice to the private respondents is also required. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the records. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, purely as an interim measure, parties are directed to maintain the status-quo over the suit land as it exists today, till the next date of hearing.
