27.06.2018	Mr. Sandeep Shrivastava, counsel for the appellant. State by Mr. Suryakant Mishra, Panel Lawyer. Heard on I.A.No.1 of 2017 for suspension of sentence and grant of bail. The appellant stands convicted by the Judgment dated 12.01.2017 passed by the learned Special Judge (NDPS Act) Raipur in Special Case No.51 of 2016 for the offence punishable u/s 20(b)(ii)(B) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and sentenced to undergo R.I., for 5 years and to pay a fine of Rs.20,000/- with further default stipulation. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that out of the total out total imprisonment of 5 years, the appellant has already served the jail sentence of more than 2 years and 4 months that is nearly half of the substantive jail sentence and the reason for moving the application is that the mother of the appellant is seriously ill and the appeal being of the year 2017, final hearing of the same will likely to take time, therefore, appellant may be enlarged on bail. Considering the fact that out of the sentence of 5 years R.I., the appellant has already suffered the jail sentence of more than 2 years and 4 months and considering the submission of the learned counsel that the mother of appellant is seriously ill and final hearing of the appeal will take considerable time, I am inclined to	



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suspend the jail remaining jail sentence of the appellant and release him on bail.

Accordingly, I.A.No. 1/2017 is allowed and it is directed that the execution of further substantive jail sentence of the appellant shall remain suspended and he shall be released on bail on his executing a personal bond in sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the trial Court for his appearance before the Registry of this Court on **25.10.2018**. He shall thereafter appear before the trial Court on a date to be given by the Registry of this Court and shall continue to appear there on all such subsequent dates as are given to him by the said Court till the disposal of this appeal.

Accordingly, I.A. No.1/2018 for urgent hearing stands disposed.
