06.10.2025	Petitioner appeared in person. Shri VA Goverdhan, counsel for respondent-1/CBI. Ms Laxmeen Kashyap, PL appears on behalf of Shri Saurabh Pandey, counsel for respondent-2/ED. Ms Pragya Shrivastava, Dy GA for the State. Shri Ashish Surana, counsel for respondent-6 through virtual mode. Petitioner has filed the present petition claiming for CBI & ED investigation in the matter, for which he has made a complaint, and FIR No.0230 has been registered at Police Station Bilaigarh, District-Baloda Bazar for the offence punishable under Section 420 of the IPC. It is pointed out by learned counsel for respondent-1 that from document Annexure P3, which is annexed with the petition, Police has

proceeded for closure report, which has been allegedly submitted before the Court.

At this juncture, learned counsel appearing for the State prays for some time to seek instructions in the matter.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent-6 also placed objection that in the present petition, High Court has been made/arrayed as party respondent un-necessarily, though there is no such relief from the High Court.

When specific query has been asked from the petitioner about allegation on the High Court, he could not give a satisfactory reply with respect to making the High Court of Chhattisgarh as party respondent. Hence, petitioner is directed to delete respondent-6/Hon'ble High Court CG from the array of cause-title in this petition, within a week from today.

Petitioner prays for listing this case on 10th November, 2025.

As prayed, list this case on **10th November, 2025**. In the meantime, State shall seek instructions about status of the closure report as submitted by the Police vide Annexure P3.
