No.01/2025, application under Section 430 of BNSS for suspension of sentence and grant of bail. By the impugned judgment dated 07.08.2025 passed by learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge, Balod, District Balod (CG) in Sessions Trial No. 03/2025, the appellant has been convicted and sentenced as under:-

Conviction	Sentence
U/s 109 of BNS	R.I. for 7 years and fine of Rs.100/-, in default of payment of fine, additional R.I. for 1 month.
Learned counsel for appellant submits that the appellant is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case on account of land dispute. She submits that there are various contradictions and omissions in the statement of prosecution witnesses and the trial court has not properly scrutinized the same before convicting the appellant. She submits that the appellant is very poor person and is only earning member of his family. She further submits that the appellant is in jail since 25.10.2024 and there is no likelihood of its early final disposal. Therefore, considering all these facts the jail sentence of appellant may be suspended till the final disposal of this appeal and the appellant be released on bail. On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the State as well the Objector opposed the bail application. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record. Taking into consideration the entire facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the nature and gravity of offence and the material available on record against the appellant, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the appellant. Accordingly, I.A. No.01 for suspension of sentence and grant of bail stands rejected.	

It is an admitted appeal and trial Court record has already been received.

Let it be listed for final hearing in the month of March, 2026.
