HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR**CRA No. 1800 of 2025****SUDDHU SINGH URF NAN BABA *versus* STATE OF CHHATTISGARH****Order Sheet**

24/07/2026	Mr. Abdul Wahab Khan, counsel for the appellant. Ms. Isha Jajodia, PL for the State. Heard on I.A. No. 03/2026, which is the third application preferred by the appellant under Section 389 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking suspension of sentence and grant of bail during the pendency of the appeal. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of five years. It is contended that the appellant has already undergone incarceration for about one year and four months and, the final hearing is not likely to take place in the near future therefore, the substantive sentence imposed upon the appellant be suspended and he

be enlarged on bail during the pendency of the appeal.

Per contra, learned State counsel opposes the application and submits that the earlier two applications of the appellant seeking suspension of sentence and grant of bail have already been rejected by this Court and therefore the appellant is not entitled to the relief sought.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties at length and perused the record of the trial Court.

Considering the rival submissions and upon perusal of the material available on record, particularly the fact that the appellant stands convicted for the offence punishable under Section 304 Part II of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for five years, coupled with the fact that his earlier two applications for suspension of sentence and grant of bail have already been rejected by this Court, I am not inclined to suspend the sentence and enlarge the appellant on bail at this stage.

Accordingly, I.A. No. 03/2026, which is the third application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail, stands rejected.
