27.01.2026	Ms. Akanchha Vishwakarma, Advocate holding the brief of Mr. A.N. Pandey, Advocate for the appellants. Mr. R.N. Pusty, Advocate along with Mr. Akash Shrivastava, Advocate for respondent No. 3/Insurance Company. None for other respondents, though served. Heard on I.A. No. 01/2022, an application for condonation of delay. Learned counsel for the appellants would submit that this appeal has been preferred by the claimants for enhancement of compensation with delay of 117 days. She would submit that due to poverty and ignorance of law, claimants could not prefer appeal within period of limitation. She would pray to condone the delay. On the other hand, Mr. Pusty would oppose. He would submit that

the claimants failed to explain sufficient cause of delay of 117 days, and therefore, application deserves to be rejected.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the application.

Taking into consideration the submission advanced by Ms. Vishwakarma and reasons assigned in the application, I.A. No. 01/2022 is allowed and delay of 117 days caused in filing instant appeal is hereby condoned.
