On due consideration and for the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and delay of 276 days in filing the appeal is hereby condoned. Let notice to the respondents be issued on payment of P.F. by ordinary and speed post mode within a period of ten working days, failing which the appeal shall stand dismissed without reference to the Bench. Also heard on I.A.No. 01/2024 an application for grant of stay. It is ordered that on appellants depositing 50% out of the total awarded amount along-with interest before the learned Claims Tribunal within a period of 60 days from today, the recovery of the remaining amount shall remain stayed against

	the appellants. If the interim order is not complied with and the deposit receipt is not filed within in a period of 60 days, the appeal shall be treated as dismissed without reference to the Bench.
