Vide order dated 16.08.2024, this Court has passed the following order: “Learned counsel for the respondent No. 2 is directed to file the RTO report with regard to difference in the Chassis and engine Number of vehicle and RC book.” Today, when the matter is called for hearing, no one is appeared on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant nor the order dated 16.08.2024 is complied with. Heard on IA No.1, application for grant of interim relief. Perusal of records shows that respondent No.2/complainant has lodged a report/complaint before the

	Police Station- Bodhghat, but the Police has not registered the case against the accused. Vide Annexure P-1, respondent No.2 has written a complaint under Section 155 of Cr.PC mentioning that it is a case of dispute of money between the parties, thereafter, respondent No.2 has filed a complaint case against the petitioners before the concerned Magistrate. Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that learned Magistrate has registered a case against the petitioners under Section 420/34 of IPC without any documents/material on record. Considering facts of the case, submissions of counsel for the parties, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that further proceedings of Complaint Case No.399/2022 pending before learned CJM, Jagdalpur, District Bastar, (CG) shall stayed till the next date of hearing.
