1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking following reliefs:-

“10.1. That this Hon'ble Court may kindly issue the writ (s)/ order(s)/direction (s) to respondent authorities to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 16/05/2025 (Annexure P/1) and provide him the eligible post based on his seniority, with all consequential benefits, including arrears of pay and allowances from the set date of promotion.

10.2. That, this Hon'ble Court may kind enough to grant any other relief (s), which is deemed fit and proper in the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that aggrieved with wrong fixation of seniority petitioner has already submitted representation dated 16.5.2025, Annexure P-1, before the respondent No.3, which is pending consideration till date, therefore, a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to take decision on pending representation of petitioner at the earliest within specified time.

3. Learned State Counsel submits that he is having no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for petitioner.

4. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.



5. On due consideration of submission of learned counsel for respective parties, this writ petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.3 to take decision on pending representation of petitioner dated 16.5.2025, Annexure P-1, in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the order.
