Learned counsel for the appellant submits that after filing of this appeal he has been restrained from meeting with his child residing with his maternal grand mother and maternal aunt. Submission made by the appellant is disputed by the respondent, he submits that earlier the appellant use to come to meet his child, however, after filing of the appeal, he is not visiting the house at Kanker to meet with his child. The submission made by the respondent is disputed by the appellant. We have heard learned counsel for the parties also parties present virtually and perused the impugned judgment passed by learned Family Court. In the impugned judgment

Ravi Mandavi	learned Family Court has passed an order granting visiting rights to the appellant-father to meet his child twice in a month. During the course of argument the respondents have submitted that they will not made any objection in meeting of appellant with his child residing with them. Considering the above facts of the case, we direct that the appellant shall meet his child twice i.e. on 1st and 3rd Sunday of every month in Kanker and he is also permitted to take his child in near by places of the house or within the City of Kanker along with him.
