18/01/2024	Heard Mr. Abhinav Kardekar and Mr. Ayush Singh Solanki, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. Vinay Pandey, learned Deputy Advocate General, appearing for the respondents/State. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in a similar situation, in Writ Petition (C) No.1782 of 2012, an order was passed by coordinate Bench of Hon'ble the Chief Justice Shri P.R.Ramchandra Menon and Hon'ble Shri Justice Parth Prateem Sahu and the notification impugned therein was also challenged and the petitioner is also entitled for the benefit which has been granted by coordinate Bench of this Court in Writ Petition (C) No.1782 of 2012. Hence, the petitioner may also be granted the same relief. On the other hand, learned Deputy Advocate General appearing for the respondents/State has pointed out that though the notification impugned was challenged in the said writ petition, but the same was not set-aside and the relief was granted to the petitioners therein. Hence, he may be allowed some time to file reply in the present case. Considering the fact that the order dated 04.10.2019 was passed by coordinate Bench of this Court, it would be more appropriate to place

the matter before the Bench in which Parth Prateem Sahu, J. is also a member after nomination from Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
