Since the earlier notice issued to respondent No.1 has returned unserved as the address was not found, let fresh notice be issued to respondent No.1 on his correct address on payment of PF as per rules by ordinary as well as registered mode. One due consideration, IA No.1, an application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is allowed and the delay is condoned. Heard on IA No.02, an application for grant of stay. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, purely as in interim measure, it is directed that if the appellant deposits 75% of the impugned award before the concerned Tribunal within a period of 60 days, the execution of the remaining part of the impugned award shall remain stayed until further orders. The claimant(s) would be at liberty to withdraw the said amount in terms of the impugned award, which shall be subject to the final outcome of the appeal.
