

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****WPS No. 11589 of 2025****PRADEEP YADAV versus STATE OF CHHATTISGARH****Order Sheet**

15/01/2026	Mr. Vikas Dubey, Counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Suyash Dhar Badgaiya, Government Advocate for State/respondent no. 1 Dr. Sudeep Agrawal, Counsel for respondent no. 2. Mr. H.B. Agrawal, learned Senior Advocate along with Ms. Priti Yadav, counsel for respondent no. 3. Heard. Issue notice to respondents. Mr. Badgaiya, Dr. Agrawal and Mr. Agrawal accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 1, 2 and 3 respectively. Hence process fee is not required to be paid for these respondents. They pray for and is granted two week's time to file reply. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is holding the post of Executive Engineer and is posted in Municipal Corporation, Raipur. By impugned order passed by State Government petitioner is transferred to Municipal Corporation, Raigarh. He submits that according to settled
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alfiza	law, the employees of one Municipal Corporation cannot be transferred to another Municipal Corporation but if necessitated he/she can be posted on deputation. The impugned order is not the order of deputation. Though the petitioner is relieved yesterday, however as per information there is no vacant post of Executive Engineer in Municipal Corporation, Raigarh. Learned counsel for respondent no. 3 would submit that according to his instructions there is only one sanction post of Executive Engineer and one person is already posted there. In the aforementioned facts of the case, it is directed that the order of transfer, so far as it relates to the petitioner shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.
