Heard Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that for the post Lecturer, there are two feeder cadre, 50% are by direct recruitment and 50% by promotion. The petitioners being the Headmaster are holding the requisite qualification of their Post Graduate as also they have completed the requisite services; however, the DPC was not held this year, consequently, they are deprived to be promoted. If by direct recruitment, the others are appointed, they cannot be given the seniority over and above as against the petitioners. State counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and is directed to file reply. Perused the documents and schedule of the recruitment. Taking into the fact that the petitioners are working since 2010, it is directed that the recruitment process may go on, however, the seniority shall not be finalized qua the petitioners by giving seniority to the direct recruitees, till the next date of hearing.
