The instant petition has been filed challenging the order dated 12/09/2025 whereby the compromise application filed by the applicants as well as complainant under Sections 320 (2) & 320 (8) of the Cr.P.C. for compounding the offence under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B, 34 of IPC has been rejected in Criminal Case No.744/2024. Learned counsel for the parties would contend that the dispute between the parties have already been settled outside the Court, however, the learned trial Court has rejected the

applications under Section 320(2) & 320 (8) of the Cr.P.C. on the ground that certain offences are non-compoundable.

Considering the entire facts & circumstances of the case and particularly the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in {2012 (10) SCC 303}, it would be appropriate to direct the parties to appear before the Additional Registrar (Judicial) to record their statements on 02nd December, 2025.

List the matter thereafter.
