Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is eligible to be considered for promotion in the year 2005, after completion of five years of service and despite pursuance made by filing of the writ petition before this court, contempt proceeding initiated against the respondent officers DPC was conducted and they have been promoted in the year 2022, causing irreparable loss to the petitioner as the right of the future prospectus of the petitioner has been adversely affected. Let State file return indicating what is the reason for delay in conducting DPC, whether sanctioned post is available, whether rules are already in existence during intermediate period. State shall also file return considering the Rules for promotion 2003 which provides that DPC has to be conducted every year. State shall also verify whether Kramonnati at the time of relevant period has been given to them or nor. Let this exercise be done by the State on the next date of hearing.
