09.02.2026	Mr. Ashutosh Rathore, counsel for the appellant. Mr. Amiyakant Tiwari, counsel for respondents No. 1 to 6. Heard on I.A. No. 01/2025, , an application for grant of stay/interim relief. Learned counsel for the appellant/Insurance Company would submit that Section 149 (4) of Motor Vehicle Act was substituted with Section 150 of the Motor Vehicle Act. He would contend that provision of “pay and recover” has been deleted, but the learned Tribunal has directed the Insurance Company to pay the compensation amount first and recover it from owner & driver of the vehicle, which is contrary to the provisions of Section 150 of Motor Vehicle Act. He would pray for grant of stay. On the other hand, learned counsel for claimants would oppose. Taking into consideration the submission made by Mr. Rathore, if the

Insurance Company deposits 90% of award amount with interest component within a period of 60 days from today, the execution of remaining amount shall remain stayed.

The claimants shall be at liberty to withdraw the amount as per terms mentioned in award, once deposited.
