19/03/2026	Mr. R.S. Patel, counsel for petitioner. Mr. Suyashdhar Badgaiya, counsel for respondents No.2 and 5. Heard. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 and 5 would submit that respondent No.1 has been wrongly arrayed as party, he was not posted in the said department at any point of time as per his instruction. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he will take appropriate steps in this regard. Learned counsel for petitioner further submits that though decision has been taken and payment of Rs.6,21,281/- has been made to petitioner, however it was not paid within time as prescribed by the Court while deciding the writ petition, hence, petitioner is entitled for interest as mentioned therein.
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Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 5 would submit that amount could not be disbursed in terms of order passed in writ petition as department has preferred writ appeal and thereafter, SLP, before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. He however, submits that he may be granted further three weeks time to seek instruction in the matter.
