Mr. Anand Kesharwani, Advocate for Respondent no. 2 to 7. Heard on IA No. 01/2025, application for grant of interim relief/stay. Counsel for the appellants submits that in compliance of the impugned award passed by the learned Claims Tribunal, the Insurance Company deposited entire amount of compensation which was also withdrawn by the claimants. Pursuant to the pay and recover direction issued by learned Claims Tribunal, Insurance Company filed an execution proceedings of which notice has already been received

by appellants herein, and the next date of hearing is fixed on 28.08.2025. Therefore, till this appeal is heard finally, some interim protection may be granted. He submits that the appellants are having prima facie good case in their favor.

Counsel for respondent no. 1 opposes the submission.

I have heard learned counsel for respective parties.

On due consideration of the pleadings made in the application, submission of learned counsel for appellants as also contents of impugned award passed by the Claims Tribunal, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that upon appellants' depositing 20% of the amount of compensation, as awarded by learned Claims Tribunal within a period of two month, recovery of remaining amount of compensation shall remain stayed till next date of hearing.

List this case after two months.
