10/11/2025	Heard Mr. Ankit Singh, learned counsel for the applicant. Also heard Smt. Supriya Upasane, learned Government Advocate, appearing for the respondent/State. This is the second bail application of the applicant. First bail application of the applicant was rejected by this Court vide order dated 13.05.2025 in MCRC No. 3814 of 2025 on merits. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been in judicial custody since 11.07.2024. It is further submitted that although charges have been framed, none of the prosecution witnesses, including the complainant have appeared to get their evidence



	recorded. Despite the issuance of warrant of arrest by the learned trial Court on 13.08.2025 and on seven subsequent occasions thereafter, neither the complainant nor any of the other prosecution witnesses have turned up before the trial Court for recording of their statement. Considering the aforesaid fact, the Superintendent of Police, Raipur, is directed to file his personal affidavit, showing as to what steps have been taken against the complainant and other prosecution witnesses against whom warrants of arrest have been issued without being handcuffed, as it appears from the order-sheet of the trial Court. Let the matter be listed on 18th November, 2025. Learned State counsel is directed to communicate this order to the Superintendent of Police, Raipur for necessary information and compliance.
