

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****MCRC No. 8790 of 2025****Sudhir Kumar Sharma *Versus* State of Chhattisgarh****Order Sheet**

10/12/2025	Heard Mr. Sangeet Kumar Kushwaha, learned counsel for the applicant. Also heard Mr. Nitansh Jaiswal, learned Panel Lawyer appearing for the non-applicant/State. Learned State counsel has pointed out that the charge-sheet has been submitted against the present applicant on 19.09.2025 and the offence under Section 66(D) of the IT Act has also been added, though the FIR was registered on 26.05.2025 for the offences under Sections 317(4), 318(4), 319(2) and 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. It is submitted that the bail application of the applicant was rejected on 01.10.2025 for the offence in question, even though the

charge-sheet, wherein Section 66(D) of the IT Act was added, had already been filed earlier on 19.09.2025, and thus the applicant has not moved any bail application for the said offence.

Accordingly, learned counsel for the applicant is directed to file a fresh bail application, and he is at liberty to move a bail application for the said offence also, and to file a certified copy of the order, if the same is rejected.

In view of the aforesaid submission, some time is granted to the learned counsel for the applicant to file the certified copy of the corrected order.

Let the matter be listed again after six weeks.
