01/05/2026	Mr. K. P. S. Gandhi, learned counsel for the appellant. Mr. Pavas Sharma, learned counsel for respondents No. 1 to 3. Heard on I. A. No. 01 of 2025, which is an application for grant of stay. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that an application was filed under Section 163(A) of the Motor Vehicle Act, wherein the learned Claims Tribunal has awarded compensation of Rs. 5,00,000/- which could not have been deposited before the learned Claims Tribunal. Opposing the submission, Mr. Sharma, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 3 submits that the deceased was the driver of the offending vehicle and

premium of Rs. 50/- was charged by the Insurance Company for legal liability for driver, thus no case for interim relief is made out.

After considering the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and also considering that admittedly there is a premium charged for covering the risk for the driver, this Court is not inclined to grant interim relief to the appellant. Thus, application (I. A. No. 01 of 2025) is dismissed.

Mr. Sharma, learned counsel submits that respondent have filed an cross-objection.

Let notice be issued cross-objection be issued to respondent No. 4 on payment of process fee as per rules. Failing which the cross-objection shall stand dismissed without further reference to this Bench.
