1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition, seeking following reliefs:-

“10.1 A writ and/or an order in the nature of writ of appropriate nature do issue calling the relevant records pertaining to case of the petitioner from the respondents concerned for its kind perusal.

10.2 A writ and/or order in the nature of writ of appropriate nature do issue directing the respondent authority to decide the representation of the petitioner for grant of increased salary as per finance direction dated 02.08.2023 within time frame fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

10.3 A writ and/or order in the nature of writ of appropriate nature do issue directing the respondent no. 2 to pay increased salary since 02.08.2023 to the petitioner as per direction issued by finance department dated 02.08.2023 in facts and circumstances of the case.

10.3 Cost of the proceedings.

10.4 Any other writs & directions that may be deemed fit and just in the facts and circumstances of the case. ”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already submitted representation to Registrar, Co-operative Societies along with others, however, representation submitted by petitioner has not been considered and decided, therefore, direction be issued to Registrar, Co-operative Societies to consider and take decision on



representation Annexure P-5 dated 01 April, 2025 expeditiously, within a specified time frame.

3. Learned counsel for State submits that in view of limited prayer made by learned counsel for petitioner he is having no objection.
4. I have heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
5. On due consideration of submission made by learned counsel for the respective parties, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, I find it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition at this stage directing concerned respondent authority i.e. Registrar, Co-operative Societies to consider and take decision on representation Annexure P-5 dated 01.04.2025 submitted by petitioner, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within a further period of four months from the date of receipt of the order.
6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, this writ petition is disposed of.
