

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****WPS No. 13883 of 2025****UNION OF INDIA *versus* ADNAN MASAN****Order Sheet**

12/12/2025	Mr. Shashank Thakur, counsel for the petitioners. Issue notice to respondent as well as on I.A. No. 1/2025, which is an application for grant of interim relief/stay on payment of process fee through ordinary as well as speed post. PF as per rules. Heard on I.A. No. 2/2025, which is an application for exemption from filing certified copy of the impugned order dated 10.7.2025. On due consideration and for the reasons mentioned in the application, I.A. No. 2/2025 is hereby dismissed.



	Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to file certified copy within a period of seven days. Also, Heard on I.A. No. 1/2025, which is an application for grant of interim relief/stay. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition has been filed assailing the order dated 10.07.2025 passed in O.A. No. 2664/2024 by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, whereby the Tribunal allowed the Original Application filed by the respondent and quashed the orders dated 24.11.2023 and 19.03.2024 issued by petitioner No. 2, further directing the authorities to permit withdrawal of the respondent's resignation and allow him to rejoin his previous post with all consequential benefits. It was contended that the petitioners have a strong prima facie case and reasonable prospects of success, whereas the final adjudication of the petition is likely to take considerable time. It was further urged that if the effect and operation of the impugned order dated 10.07.2025 is not stayed,
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	the petitioners would suffer irreparable loss and the very purpose of filing the present petition would be rendered infructuous.
