Issue notice to the respondents No. 1, 2 & 4 on payment PF within 7 working days by ordinary and speed post, failing which the writ petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench. Heard on I. A. No.1 application for grant of Ad-interim relief. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is the defendant in Civil Suit No. 7A/2017 pending consideration before the Civil Judge, Class-I, Rajpur, District Balrampur–Ramanujganj (C.G.) had filed an application under Order VI Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking

amendment of the written statement which was rejected by the impugned order. He further submits that the trial has not yet commenced and, therefore, rejection of the said application is bad in law.

Be that as it may, further proceedings in Civil Appeal No. A Class/73/2024 pending before the Civil Judge, Class-I, Rajpur, District Balrampur–Ramanujganj (C.G.), shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.
