Let the record of Complaint Case No.CC/2022/72 from District Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission Janjgir, District Janjgir-Champa (C.G.). Heard on I.A. No.1/2025, application for grant of interim relief/stay in execution proceeding. The challenge in this writ petition is to order dated 14.11.2025 (Annexure-P/1) passed in Second Appeal No.749/2025 by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal

Commission at New Delhi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that second appeal filed by the petitioner against the order of State Commission, Raipur (C.G.) was rejected only on the ground of limitation. He further submits that respondents have initiated the execution proceedings and an order to send the petitioner to Civil Jail has also been passed. Therefore, interim relief may be granted.

Opposing the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the respondent submits that State Commission as well as the National Commission has given a finding of fact against the petitioner. The petitioner is not complying with the order, and thus, order of sending him to Civil Jail was passed by the District Commission.

From perusal of record, it appears that an order of Rs.5,42,000/- along with 6% interest is passed against the petitioner plus Rs.30,000/- for mental/physical agony and Rs.5,000/- for the cost of litigation.

As an order of sending petitioner to Civil Jail has been filed, it is ordered that subject to payment of Rs.3 Lakhs within a period of 30 days from today to the satisfaction of District Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission Janjgir, District Janjgir-Champa (C.G.) and the arrest warrant issued against the petitioner shall not be acted upon. If, the amount is deposited,
