Learned counsel for petitioner submits that earlier the writ petition was filed against the constitution of committee by the Collector for demarcating of land, subject matter of this writ petition on the ground that there was no proper map of area, so as to demarcate the land as sought for by respondent no. 7. He further submits that writ petition was disposed of on the submission made by learned counsel for State that Revenue Authority upon search of that soft copy of map is available and on that basis demarcation can be made based upon which writ petition was disposed of directing authorities for demarcating the area in accordance with law. When the petitioner has submitted an application asking the concerned authority to supply the soft copy of map he informed that there is no such soft copy of area of relevant period available. Issue notice to respondents.

alfiza	Mrs. Poorva Tiwari, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 1 to 6. On payment of process fee, issue notice to respondent no. 7. Process fee, as per rules. Notice be made returnable within three weeks. Also heard on IA No. 01/2025, which is an application for grant of interim relief/stay. Considering the submission made by learned counsel for the respective parties as also the dispute raised in this writ petition, the proceedings of the demarcation is stayed till the next date of hearing.
