12/01/2026	Mr. Bhupendra Singh, counsel for the petitioners. Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Agrawal, P.L. for the State/respondent No.6. Heard. Issue notice to the respondents No.1 to 5 & 7 by ordinary as well as by speed post. P.F. be paid within 7 working days, failing which the instant petition shall stands dismissed without any further reference to the Bench. Also heard on I.A. No.1/2025, application for grant of interim relief. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that challenge in this writ petition is to an order dated 14.11.2025 passed by the Civil Judge, Class-I, Senior Division, Additional Judge Ramanujganj at Rajpur, District Balrampur-Ramanujganj (C.G.) in Civil Suit No.13A/2016, whereby the application filed under Section 151 of CPC to exhibit the documents, which were part of the record has been rejected. It is further submitted that civil suit was filed by the respondents No.1 to 3 seeking declaration of title

and permanent injunction. The petitioner being defendants, filed certain documents to prove its pleadings. However, during the examination of the witnesses of the defendants, those documents cannot be exhibited on account of some mistake, Thus the application was filed, which was rejected.

Be that as it may, it is directed that further proceedings with regard to the Civil Suit No.13A/2016 pending before the Civil Judge, Class-I, Senior Division, Additional Judge Ramanujganj at Rajpur, District Balrampur-Ramanujganj (C.G.), shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.
