No. 2 of 2025 is an application for condonation of delay of 380 days in preferring the appeal. Since Mr. Prasun Bhaduri, learned Deputy

Advocate General appearing for the respondent/State, has no objection to the condonation of delay, and considering that the appellant has a statutory right to prefer an appeal, and further that the cause shown for filing the appeal beyond the prescribed period appears to be satisfactory, the delay in filing the present appeal is hereby condoned.

Accordingly, the appeal is admitted.

Since Mr. Prasun Bhaduri, learned Deputy Advocate General, has already entered appearance on behalf of the respondent/State, issuance of fresh notice to the respondent is dispensed with.

Learned State counsel is directed to file its reply/objection to I.A. No. 1 of 2025 (application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail) within a period of two weeks. The learned State counsel is also directed to inform this Court regarding the criminal antecedents of the appellant.

The record of the learned trial Court has already been received.

List the matter after eight weeks for consideration on I.A. No. 1 of 2025 (application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail).
