On due consideration, I.A. No.1 for exemption from filing certified copy is allowed. A cross objection under Order 41 Rule 22 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed by respondents No.1 and 2 along with an application for condonation of delay (I.A.No.3) in filing the cross objection. Though the application for condonation of delay is opposed, looking to the reasons assigned in the
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	application, delay in filing the cross objection is condoned. I.A. No.3 is allowed. Also heard on admission of the cross objection. Admit. Issue notice. Shri Sourabh Sharma, learned Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the appellant. Let notice on the cross objection be issued to respondents No.3 and 4 by ordinary and speed posts. P.F. be paid within a period of 10 working days, failure of which would lead to automatic dismissal of the cross objection.
