As the case is listed for orders on default pointed out by the Registry with regard to Annexure A/2, i.e. the order dated 22/11/1999 passed by the learned Civil Judge, Class-I, Katghora, District Korba (C.G.) in Civil Suit No. 24-A/1998, it is noted that some part of the said document is faint and not easily readable. Learned counsel for the appellant, in response to the said default, submits that the appellant has already applied for a certified copy of the order dated 22/11/1999; however, for one reason or the other, the same has not been supplied. He would further submit

that due to non-supply of the certified copy, the appellant was constrained to prefer a writ petition bearing WP227 No. 593 of 2025, wherein this Court had directed the concerned authority to provide the certified copy of the judgment dated 22/11/1999 to the appellant herein. In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, the default raised by the Registry is hereby overruled.
