Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aggrieved and prejudiced by the impugned action of the respondents, whereby the work order issued pursuant to Tender Notice No. 608 dated 16.10.2024 has been arbitrarily cancelled and the petitioner-firm, M/s Aman Construction, through its proprietor Smt. Bharati Banpuriya, has been blacklisted/debarred for a period of one year, and further that the respondents are proceeding to initiate a fresh tender process in respect of the very same works. It is contended that the said action is ex

Bablu	facie illegal, unjust, and violative of the principles of natural justice, and is vitiated by malafides and non-application of mind, thereby infringing the petitioner's fundamental and statutory rights. Issue notice to the respondents. Mr.S.S.Baghel, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Notice be issued to respondent No. 3 by speed post and served through the District Magistrate, Durg, who may appear either in person or through counsel. Process fee be paid within two days. List this matter in the next week. The State Counsel is directed to communicate this order to the District Magistrate, Durg for necessary compliance.
