13/01/2026	Heard Mr.Pragalbh Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr.S.S.Baghel, learned Government Advocate, appearing for the State/respondent No.1 and Mr.Anumeh Shrivastava, learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 and perused the impugned FIR as well as material brought on record. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that there is a matrimonial dispute between petitioner No. 1 and respondent No. 2 and marriage between them was solemnized on 01.12.2020 and the present FIR has been lodged by respondent No. 2 against the petitioners for harassment on 12.07.2025. He further submits that the present matter be referred to Mediation Centre of this Court being matrimonial in nature as there may be chances of compromise between the parties. Considering the fact that the dispute arrived at between the parties i.e. petitioner No. 1 and respondent No. 2 is matrimonial in nature, we deem it appropriate to make an effort to get the said dispute settled by way of



mediation.

In view of above, petitioner No. 1 shall deposit Rs. 50,000/- with the Mediation Centre of this Court and the same shall be paid to respondent No. 2 on her appearance before the Mediation Centre.

The matter is remitted to the Mediation Centre of this Court. Parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on 16.01.2026.

List this matter on 23.01.2026 along with Mediation Centre report.

Till the next date of listing, the petitioners shall not be arrested pursuant to the impugned FIR No. 631 of 2025 for offence under Sections 85, 351(2), 115(2) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station Janjgir, District Janjgir Champa.

The petitioners are directed to produce a copy of receipt before the Superintendent of Police concerned regarding payment of the said amount to the Mediation Centre of this Court in pursuance of this Court's order



and then only this order shall be given into effect.

It is also made clear that if any final settlement is arrived at between the parties, the aforesaid amount so deposited, shall be adjusted.
