trial Court and has erred in convicting the appellant. He would further submit that the appellant during trial has remained in incarceration for about three months and final adjudication of the appeal will take its own time therefore, he may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State opposes the bail application.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, material on record and further considering the fact that the appeal will take its own time and also that the appellant during trial remained in incarceration for three months, I am inclined to release the appellant on bail.

Accordingly, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail to the appellant is allowed. It is directed that the jail sentence imposed upon the appellant shall remain suspended during the pendency of this appeal and he shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety in like sum to the satisfaction of the Trial Court for his appearance before the Registry of this Court on **5<sup>th</sup> October, 2026**. Thereafter, he shall appear before the trial Court on the date to be given by the Registry of this Court and shall continue to appear before the trial Court on all such subsequent dates as are given to him by the said court till the disposal of the appeal.
