20/01/2026	Shri Rajkamal Singh, counsel through V.C. and Shri Suryapratap Yuddhveer Singh, counsel for the petitioner/s. Heard. Issue notice to the respondent on payment of P.F. within 10 working days by ordinary and speed post failing which this petition shall stand automatically dismissed without further reference to the Bench. Also heard on I.A.No.1/2025, application for grant of interim relief. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent who happens to be the ex-mother-in-law of the petitioner had filed an application under Section 23 of Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 before the Sub-Divisional Officer, Raipur, C.G. with a
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Deepti	prayer that gift deed dated 08/06/2022 executed by the respondent in favour of the petitioner be canceled and the property comprised in plot No.22, Sheet No.8, part of Khasra No.536/3 and 537/5, area 2575 sq.ft. situated at Ashok Vihar Colony, Near Gupta Provision, Kali Mata Ward No.30 Village-Pandritarai, P.H.No109, RIC Raipur 01, Tahsil and District-Raipur, CG be handed over to the respondent. It is further submitted that the petitioner is the widowed daughter in law of the respondent who subsequently remarried. After re-marriage, in order to trouble the petitioner, this application has been filed. They further submit that the relief which has been claimed cannot be granted by the Maintenance Tribunal and this relief can only be granted by a competent Civil Court. Thus, taking cognizance by the Maintenance Tribunal of the said application is beyond its jurisdiction. Be that as it may, taking into consideration the above submissions and on perusal of record, this Court is of the opinion that <i>prima facie</i> case for grant of interim relief is made out. Till the next date of hearing, further proceedings of case No.202507111000526/ब/121 year 2024-25 pending in the Court of President, Maintenance Tribunal and Sub-Divisional Officer (Revenue) Raipur, District Raipur shall remain stayed.
