ORDER

1. The present petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondent to release the petitioner on parole for a period of four weeks for the purpose of filing SLP against the judgment whereby the petitioner was convicted by this Court in criminal appeal being Crl. A. 300/2017 arising out of FIR No. 309/2011 under Sections 302/307/379/34 IPC at Police Station Farsh Bazar, Delhi.

2. *Vide* order dated 17.02.2025 this Court had issued notice in the writ petition, when the learned Additional Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/State had sought time to verify the address of the present petitioner.

3. The status report has been handed over at Bar, the same is taken on record. A perusal of the status report shows that the address of the present



petitioner has been verified.

4. In view of the above, it is directed that the petitioner be released on parole for a period of four weeks, subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum Rs.20,000/- and a surety bond of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent and further subject to the following conditions:

- a. The petitioner shall not leave city/NCR region without informing the local SHO; and
- b. The petitioner shall provide his mobile number to the IO concerned which shall be kept in working condition at all times and he shall not change the mobile number without prior intimation to the Investigating Officer concerned.
- c. Upon expiry of period of four weeks as stated above, the petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the petition stands disposed of.

6. Copy of the order be forwarded to the Jail Superintendent for necessary compliance.
