1. The pleadings are yet to be completed. On the previous date, i.e., 8th January, 2026, Ms. Ahlawat had sought time to apprise the Court with regard to the vacancy position for the post of Personal Assistant advertised *vide* vacancy notice dated 12th January, 2024.
2. Ms. Ahlawat, on instructions, states that for the post reserved for OBC candidates, the number of aspiring candidates were less than the number of advertised vacancies and, consequently, all the vacancies could not be filled.
3. Considering the above, till the next date of hearing, one vacancy for the post of Personal Assistant shall remain reserved.
4. Let the counter-affidavit be filed within a period of three weeks from today. Rejoinder be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
