2. Application is disposed of.

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1. By way of the present petition filed under Section 11(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter, referred to as the 'A&C Act'), the petitioner seeks constitution of Arbitral Tribunal comprising of a Sole Arbitrator.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties had entered into a Loan Agreement dated 12.01.2018. It is stated that Clause 10.14 of the said agreement provides for resolution of disputes through arbitration and further designates New Delhi as the seat of arbitration.
3. Disputes having arisen between the parties, the petitioner invoked arbitration by issuing a notice dated 27.02.2021 to the respondent under



Section 21 of the A&C Act.

4. Issue notice to the respondents by all permissible modes including *dasti*, returnable on 10.02.2025.
5. In the meantime, reply, if any, be filed by the respondents.
