1. Petitioner herein seeks quashing of FIR No. 152/1995 dated 09.05.1995, registered at P.S. Kotla, Mubarakpur.
2. Though the FIR had been registered under multiple sections, petitioner has been charged under Section 448 IPC.
3. The charge was framed on 11.09.2024 and so far no witness has been examined.
4. Learned Senior counsel for petitioner submits that in view of the subsequent judgment, rendered in a civil dispute, the charges are not sustainable and it is in the aforesaid backdrop that the present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR.
5. Learned APP for the State-respondent No.1 appears on advance notice and seeks time to apprise the status of the ongoing criminal trial.
6. Let notice be issued to respondent No.2 through all permissible modes as also through counsel, returnable on 25.03.2026.
