ORDER

1. These are cross-appeals filed by the parties.
2. It is not possible to take up these matters for final hearing today.
3. However, learned counsel appearing for the claimants requests that 25% of the amount of the compensation with interest may be released to the claimant, who is the mother of the deceased.



4. Learned counsel appearing for the Insurance Company is not agreeable.
5. However, on a perusal of the record, this Court finds that vide order dated 08.08.2017, 25% of the amount of compensation with interest, which was directed to be deposited by the Insurance Company was allowed to be released in favour of the claimant/mother of the deceased. It is further directed that compensation to the extent of 25% of the total compensation along with accrued interest there upon be further released to claimant/mother of the deceased.
6. Copy of this order be sent to learned Tribunal for information and necessary compliance.
7. Re-notify for final hearing on 10.05.2024 at the top of the board in the category of 'Advance List'.
8. Parties are at liberty to file short written submissions not exceeding three pages along with relevant case-law within four weeks from today.
