ORDER

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1. Counsel for respondent states that respondent has got his leg fractured in May 2025 and is in cast, and, therefore, unable to come to the Court today.
2. He further informs that insolvency proceedings are going against him both personally as well as corporate. Notwithstanding, respondent commits in the interim to shore up the arrears, which as per him are in the range of *Rs.30 lakh* (whereas petitioner assesses the amount at *Rs.38.5 lakhs*).

next date of hearing.
