3. By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:

“a) Allow this Revision and set aside the judgment on conviction and sentence dated 08.01.2026 passed by the Learned Additional Sessions Judge-04, Central District, Delhi, and consequently set aside the conviction and sentence imposed upon the petitioner under Sections 468 and 198 IPC;

b) Pending adjudication of the present Criminal Revision Petition, suspend the execution of sentence and direct the release of the



petitioner on bail, and/or in the alternative be pleased to modify the sentence and extend the benefit of probation to the petitioner under Sections 4 and 6 of the Probation of Offenders Act, 1958;

c) Call for the Trial Court Record (TCR) pertaining to FIR No. 248/2008, Police Station Subzi Mandi, from the Court of the Learned JMFC-07, Central District, Delhi, along with the appellate record of Criminal Appeal No. 08/2025 from the Court of the Learned Additional Sessions Judge-04, Central District, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi;"

4. Issue notice. The learned APP accepts notice on behalf of the State and the learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of UOI. They seek time to file the Status Report/reply. Let the same be filed, at least two days prior to the next date of hearing, with an advance copy to the other side.
5. Issue notice to the complainant by all permissible modes, including electronically, as also through the concerned Investigating Officer (I.O.) returnable on the next date of hearing.
6. Let the Trial Court Record, in digitized form, be called for, at least two days prior to the next date of hearing.
7. Nominal roll and the medical status report of the petitioner be also called, from the concerned Jail Superintendent, before the next date of hearing.
8. List for arguments on the application seeking suspension of sentence on 02.03.2026.
9. The order be uploaded on the website forthwith.
