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1. Ms. Pratima N. Lakra, learned Central Government Standing Counsel, on instructions, submits that Respondents have no objection to the joint inspection of the two rakes in question and Petitioner may approach the concerned zones in Western Railway and North-Central Railway and on receipt of Petitioner's request for joint inspection, needful shall be done.
2. Ms. Madhavi Divan, learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioner submits that communication will be sent to the respective zones within three working days from today for joint inspection of the two rakes along with a proposal to repair the damage found, at the cost of the Petitioner.

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3. Petitioner may approach the concerned zonal Railways requesting for joint inspection and on receipt of the request, Respondents shall ensure that joint inspection is carried out. Proposal for repair of the damage, at the cost of the Petitioner, by the original manufacturer of the rakes, will also be looked into.
