ORDER
12.01.2024

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1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 01st November, 2023 passed in W.P.(C) No.14204/2023.
2. By order dated 01st November, 2023, directions had been given to the respondent/Municipal Corporation of Delhi ("MCD") to take appropriate action against the property bearing No. 5665, Basti Harphool Singh, Sadar Thana Road, Sadar Bazar, Delhi-110006.
3. Ms. Aakansha Kaul, learned standing counsel for MCD appearing on advance notice, submits that show cause notice with respect to the unauthorized construction has already been issued to the owner/occupier of the property in question.
4. She submits that hearing was fixed for 10th January, 2024 and the



matter is now listed before the concerned official on 23rd January, 2024 for giving hearing to the owner of the property in question.

5. She further submits that requisite action shall be taken by the MCD against the unauthorized construction after following the due process of law.

6. The aforesaid statement made on behalf of MCD is taken on record. The MCD is directed to take expeditious steps against the construction existing in the property in question, preferably within a period of four months from today.

7. In view of the aforesaid, no further directions are required to be passed in the present petition.

8. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition, if he is still aggrieved by any non-action on the part the MCD with regard to compliance of the order dated 01st November, 2023 passed by the Division Bench in *W.P.(C). No. 14204/2023*.

9. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
