Learned senior counsels for the parties have exchanged their calculations. They pray for further time to examine same.

The calculation sheets filed by the judgment debtor, copy of which is produced in the Court, shows that the judgment debtor admits that he has to pay Rs.1,26,32,320/-.

Since there is a dispute as to which of the Directors/shareholders are entitled to represent the decree holder company and receive the amount, the amount cannot be directed to be released, however, the judgment debtor is directed to deposit the said admitted amount with the Registrar General of this Court subject to further orders.

The Registrar General shall keep the said amount in an interest bearing Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR). Let the amount be deposited within a period of eight weeks.
